ALLIGATOR SENS.IT RS+ TPMS COVERS VOLVO AUTO-LEARNING VEHICLES

Alligator sens.it RS-series universal TPMS sensors cover Volvo vehicles that support auto-learning and come equipped with Continental sensors. 2014-18 S60, 2014-16 S80, 2015-19 V60, 2014-20 XC60 & 2014-16 XC70

The vehicles are an example of a continuing trend among car manufacturers - the TPMS systems on newer models support automatic learning. The Volvo vehicles' TPMS systems have an advanced auto-learning feature - the sensors work with the ABS system to automatically learn new sensor IDs (when installing new sensors) and automatically locate existing IDs (when rotating tires).

If no scan tool is available for sensor-ID registration, then techs can simply park the vehicle for 20 minutes then drive until it recognizes the new sensors. Sensors that have an auto-learning feature are especially helpful for DIYers that install wheels themselves but don't have access to a special tool for sensor-ID registration and for wheel shops that rely on the end-users to handle the TPMS learning process.

Shops that stock Alligator sens.it sensors are utilizing user-friendly TPMS units which make the techs' jobs easier, reduces unnecessary downtime in the bays for TPMS learning or sensor issues, helps the business' bottom line, and keeps its customers happy and coming back.
